4 **1. Roll Call to Order**

6 Will Ludt called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

10 **2. “Throwback Thursday” – Amherst Heritage**

12 Will Ludt presented information from Bunker Hill that included two Amherst citizens.

14 **3. Baboosic Lake B&M Rail Stop- Walnut Hill Road and the Embankment Road**

15

16 Will Ludt stated that he asked Meridian Land Services for a quote to survey a small area for the
17 proposed rail stop. Lisa Montesanto stated that the Historical Society is interested in collecting
18 items that may be found during excavation of the area.

19

20 In response to a question from Conor Frain, Will Ludt stated that there are no known photos of
21 the original rail stop.

22

23 Will Ludt noted that the small cooerage building next to the Corn Crib that is proposed to be
24 removed has asbestos. He spoke with DPW about this structure and it likely cannot be burned.
25 The groups will brainstorm about what to do with the building.

27 **4. Street Study Committee Update**

• **Pavers and Road Treatments Assistance**

29

30 Will Ludt explained that the Village Streets Study Committee was created by the Board of
31 Selectmen. There are five Village streets proposed for reconstruction in 2025. In order to
32 compliment that work, the Committee is evaluating the streets for potential improvements for
33 traffic, safety, etc. This may include sidewalks, alternative road materials, or other
34 improvements. The Town will likely seek grant funding for some of this work. The five streets
35 proposed for renovation are Carriage Road, Davis Lane, Main Street, Church Street, and Jones
36 Road. The Committee will hold a site walk on Sunday, October 15th at 11am for residents along
37 those streets.

39 Lisa Montesanto stated that she noticed a recent application before the Historic District
40 Commission to demolish parts of an historic property. She noted that the Heritage Commission
41 should review these items when they arise. Will Ludt stated that he attended the meeting and
42 spoke about receiving documentation for this item. Similar items have been received from
43 properties in the past.
